OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHIPPING NORTON AREA) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20**

Oxfordshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82 and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Chipping Norton Area) (Speed Limits) Order 202* and shall come into force on the day of 202*.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Part A of Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. The roads specified in Part B of Schedule 2 to this order are restricted roads under Section 82 (1) of "the Act" by virtue of street lighting, thereby subject to 30 miles per hour
- 5. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
- 6. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.
- 7. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 8. The Oxfordshire County Council (Chipping Norton Area) (Speed Limits) Order 2020 is hereby revoked.

The whole length of every road in Chipping Norton (excluding any roads or lengths of road listed in Schedules 2, 3 or 4) extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

<mark>d)</mark>	A361 Burford Road	a point 15 metres northwest of its junction with the B4026 Charlbury Road
<mark>e)</mark>	B4026 Over Norton Road	a point 225 metres north of its junction with Park Road
<mark>f)</mark>	B4450 Churchill Road	a point 105 metres southwest of its junction with Tilsley Road
<mark>g)</mark>	Dunstan Avenue	Its junction with the A44 New Street
